### **Support of Family Unity During The Waiver Process!!!**

On January 2, 2013, the Department of Homeland Security finally announced the approval of the final rule to promote family unity. The final rule establishes a process that allows certain individuals to apply for a provisional unlawful presence waiver before they depart the United States to attend their immigrant visa interviews in their countries of origin. The process will be effective March 4, 2013.

This final rule facilitates the legal immigration process and reduces the amount of time that U.S. Citizens are separated from their immediate relatives who are in the process of obtaining an immigrant visa.
